

Week 2 - Jesus Washes Feet

John 13:1-17

PUDDING PAINTING

Supplies: chocolate pudding, plastic wrap or washable placemats

Supplies: paper and washable paint, wide brushes or sponge brushes, water and paper towels.

Say, Jesus washed the disciples' feet because he loved them. So we are going to combine love and feet in a fun art project! Then create hearts from feet by painting washable paint onto the bottom of the foot, then having them step onto paper (like a 'v').

FOOT ON YOUR HEAD

Supplies: one paper plate and pencil per child

Let's see how well you can make a foot...on your head! Put your paper plate on your head, like this (show them), then draw a foot (make your own, being sure to show that the quality of the drawing is not the point by being lighthearted about the quality of your own drawing)

KEEP THE BALLOON UP

Supplies: inflated balloons (one per person would be fun, but it also could be fun collaborating)

Say, Since the big event in our story today is about feet, let's play a foot game. Let's see how long we can keep the balloon up in the air, but we can only use our feet to do it!
